She is Principal Geotechnical Engineer at Atkins Ltd where she leads the Cardiff Geotechnical team and is overseeing the geotechnical design for a number of major highway schemes in South Wales. She also acts as the Designer Geotechnical Advisor for South Wales Trunk Road Agent. She is a Member of the ICE, a delegated engineer and has been an ICE Reviewer for the past 4 years.



**Yvonne Ainsworth.** Yvonne started her engineering life in 1995 in Aachen, Germany where she qualified as a civil and structural engineer specialising in Geotechnics. She started work in 2001 in the UK as a consultant with Atkins. She decided she belonged in the contractor's world after her site placement with Cementation and remained working there as Design Team Leader. After a short career break travelling the world, she joined BAUER where she progressed to Construction and Technical Director. During this time she was involved in extremely challenging projects and took part in the Fleming Award 2011 with the construction of the D-shaped pile. In 2016, Yvonne set up her own business, ATD Engineering. Since then, she has worked on other interesting projects such as London City Airport, Thames Tideway and Gothenburg Central Station. She now works as General Manager for JRL Civil Engineering.
